

Doko Dare Naze

Kore wa Dare desuka?
これはだれですか？

Who is this?

Just like What is this? (Kore wa nann desuka?), we can simply use WHO/ WHERE/WHY to replace to say simple questions.

Where=Do-Ko (どこ)

Who=Da-Re (だれ)

Why=Na-ze or Nannde (なぜ・なんで)



@Rengatei Ginza Tokyo

(LOOKING AT PICTURE)
Kore wa doko desuka?
これはどこですか？

Where is this?



@Kiddy Land Harajuku Tokyo

(LOOKING AT PICTURE)
Kore wa Dare desuka?
これはだれですか？

Who is this?



@Mega Web Odaiba Tokyo

(Trying to understand why vehicle moves)
Kore wa Naze desuka?
これはなぜですか？

Why is this?

Are wa dare desu-ka?
あれはだれですか？

Who is that?

Are wa yamada-san desu.
あれはやまださんです。

That is Yamada-san.

Examples

A. **Koko wa doko-desuka?** ここはどこですか？ **Where is here?**

B. **Koko wa Rengatei desu.** ここはレンガていです。 **It's Rengatei here.**

A. **Nannde desuka?** なぜですか？ **Why?**

B. **Nazenara, Denki Jidousha dakara desu.** **Because it's Electric Car.**
